

## 14th February (Black day For India Pulwama Attack)



We Members of Mauli Nursing college Hatta has celebrated Black day for india pulvama attack on  $14^{th}$  Feb. This year we have conducted rally, we have all the students of BSc Nursing  $1^{st}$ , 2nd, 3rd and  $4^{th}$  year with All teaching and Non Teaching Staff.

We have started the Programme at 4 Pm till 5pm ended. Programme were started by rally and at last we all staff and students are gathered in ground and gave condolence central reserve Police for 15 min and we have one speech on it after condolences.



We resolutely condemn the vicious terrorist attack carried out on 14/02/2019 in Pulwama of Jammu and Kashmir. On behalf of Mauli Nursing college Hatta and people in Hatta, we would like to extend our sincere condolences to those who lost their lives and their bereaved families, and express our heartfelt sympathy to those who were injured.

On 14 February 2019, a convoy of 78 vehicles transporting more than 2,500 Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) personnel from Jammu to Srinagar was travelling on National Highway 44. The convoy had left Jammu around 03:30 IST and was carrying a large number of personnel due to the highway having been shut down for two days prior. The convoy was scheduled to reach its destination before sunset.

At Lethpora near Awantipora, around 15:15 IST, a bus carrying security personnel was rammed by a car carrying explosives. It caused a blast which killed 40 CRPF personnel of the 76th Battalion and injured many others. The injured were moved to the army base hospital in Srinagar.



Pakistan-based militant group Jaish-e-Mohammed claimed responsibility for the attack. They also released a video of the assailant Adil Ahmad Dar, a 22-year-old from Kakapora who had joined the group a year earlier. Dar's family had last seen him in March 2018, when he left his house on a bicycle one day and never returned. Pakistan denied any involvement, though Jaish-e-Mohammed's leader, Masood Azhar, is known to operate in the country. It is the deadliest terror attack on India's state security personnel in Kashmir since 1989. **THANK YOU!**
